FIXED ODDS BETTING



Allows players to bet on the movement of the financial market



Losses are bound to the stake you wager (eg. If you bet £1 you can only lose £1.)



Floating Odds Betting is another variation where the odds change for a given price as the price of the market changes



How much can be won is dependent on how much is bet at those odds.



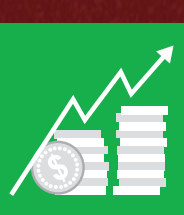
FINANCIAL SPREAD BETTING



No fixed odds



Greater potential for higher returns



Based on how stocks and shares go up or down



Tax free profits



Trade with small amounts of money



Instant access to all markets



Reduce losses with stop losses



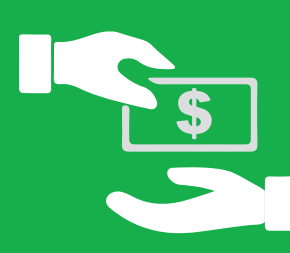
BINARY BETTING



Odds are offered from 1-100, the bet settles at 100 if the event happens or 0 if it does not



Binary betting has become of popular that many online gambling and casino brands have incorporated it into their sites



You can buy and sell at certain points so it is possible to make a profit from the event occurring or not occurring



Two possible outcomes: to win or lose, to buy and sell



Financial betting incorporates a level of skill and knowledge
