PROCESS FROM INSTALLATION TO FREEDOM & FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1 INSTALLATION DAY



FIRST TRAINING

You will be inside house and trainer will expose dog to the electric dog fence and begin to train him to his new boundaries



3 AFTER THE TRAINER FINISHES



you will walk dog in yard showing him that the yard away from flags is safe. It is completely normal for the dog to be fearful after the first few trainer sessions.

YOU WILL BRING THE DOG OUTSIDE ON LEASH 10-12 TIMES/DAY.

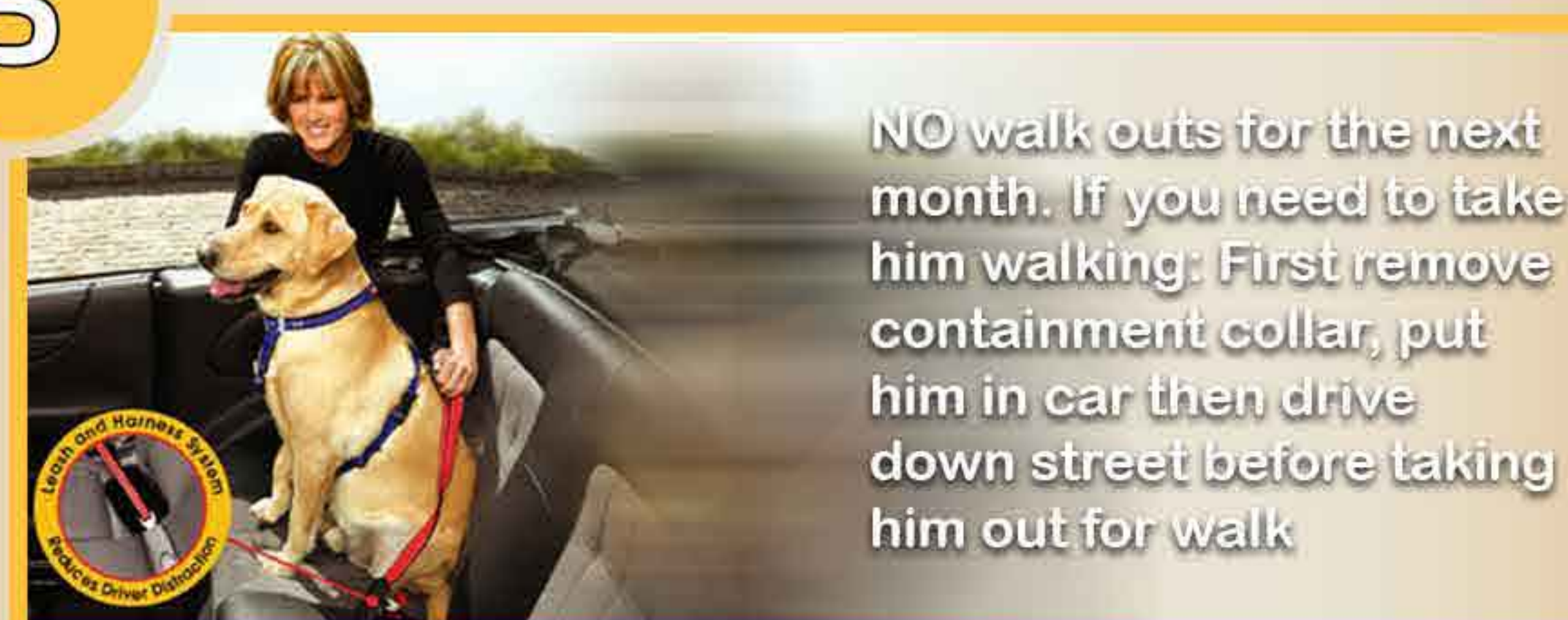

Short 3-5 minute trips in yard.
(use numbers in graphic and dog on leash)
Keep dog away from house. Keep dog from mid yard to two feet back from containment flags



IMPORTANT: Keep the dog Away from your body. The walks in yard are NOT a 'heeling training' exercise. The one and sole purpose of these walks is to allow your dog to get comfortable in the yard away from the flags.

5 AFTER THE TRAINER FINISHES



NO walk outs for the next month. If you need to take him walking: First remove containment collar, put him in car then drive down street before taking him out for walk

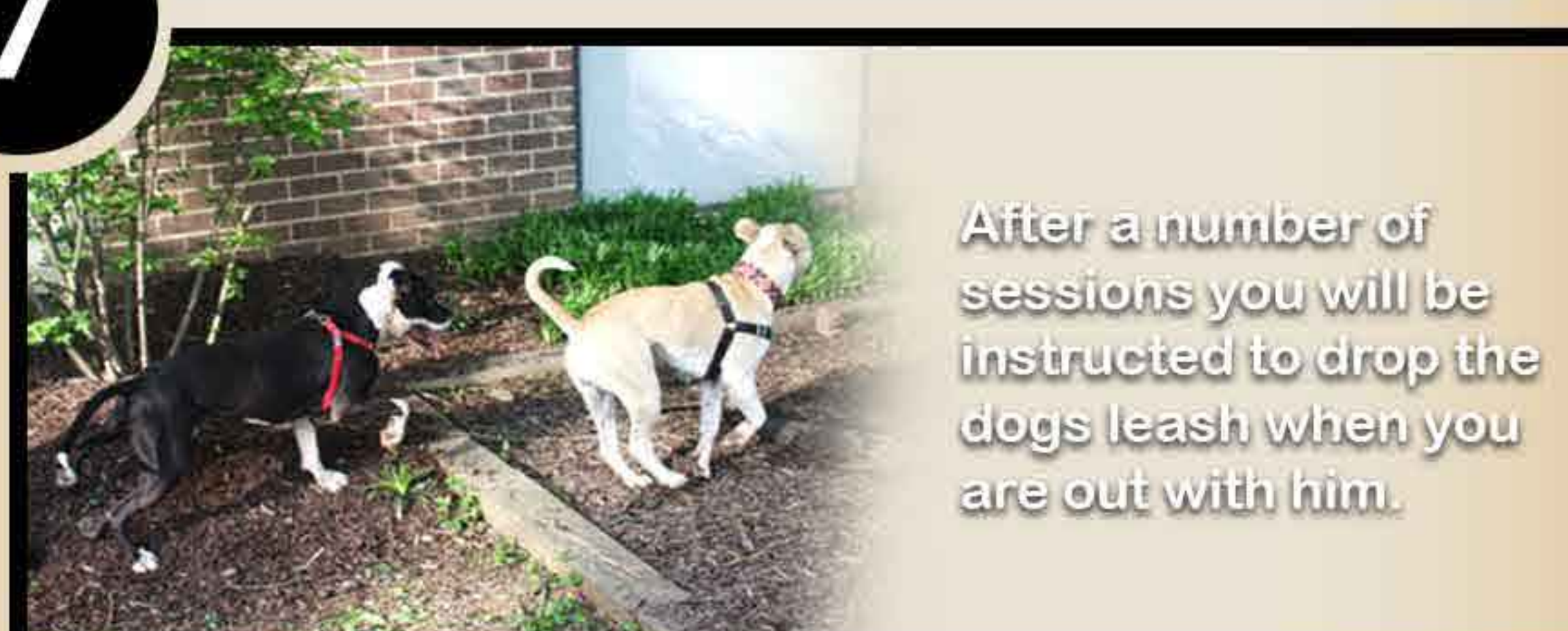
NEXT TRAINING SESSION?

Schedule your next training session when your dog is once again comfortable walking all over the yard with you, within the flagged area.



7 DROP LEASH PHASE



After a number of sessions you will be instructed to drop the dogs leash when you are out with him.

OFF LEASH MONITORED PHASE

After a while your dog will be off leash with you monitoring him in yard



9 FREEDOM



Soon you will be able to confidently open the door and let your dog out knowing exactly where he will be! Safely contained in the yard
