

iPhone 6 Plus vs Google Nexus 6 vs Samsung GALAXY Note 4

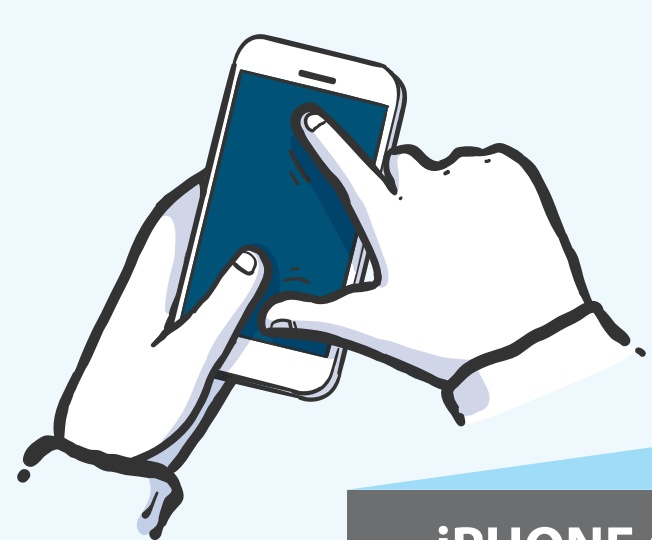


DO YOU WANT A BIG SMARTPHONE?

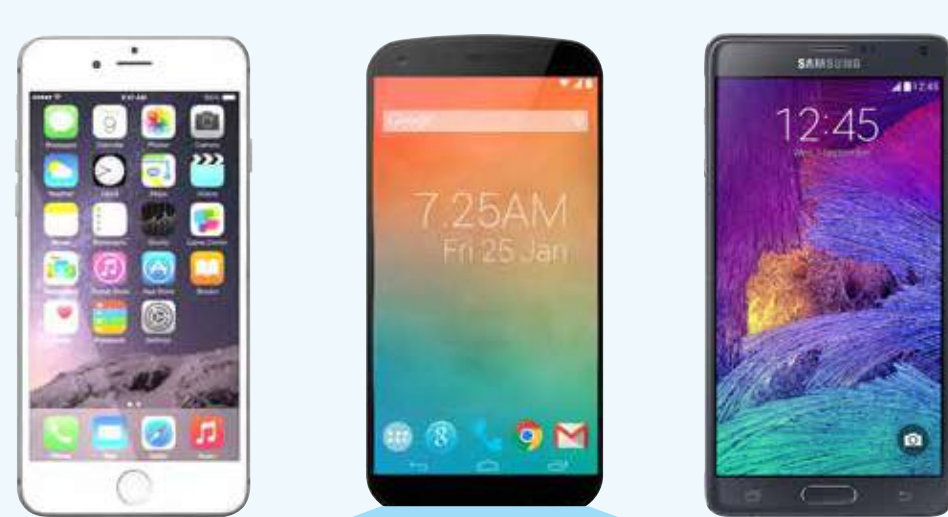
Does that large screen make you think of all the things you will be able to do better and faster? Want an exceptional camera?

You have at least 3 excellent choices and the real battle is fought between the iPhone 6 Plus, the Nexus 6 and the Note 4. Let's examine some of the key features and see which phone will be the best match for you.

DISPLAY



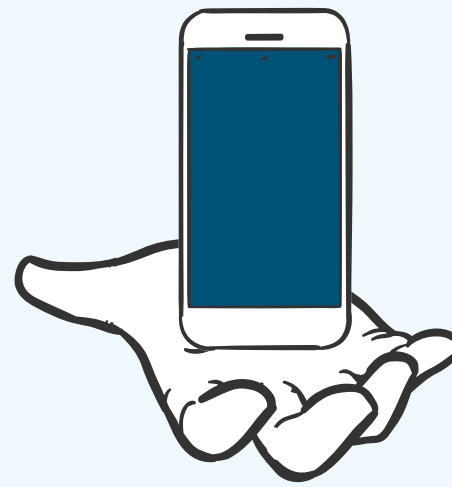
Nexus 6 has the bigger screen, but the Note 4 seems to have the greatest pixel density. If a great display is what you are looking for then the Note might be your match.

SIZE & WEIGHT

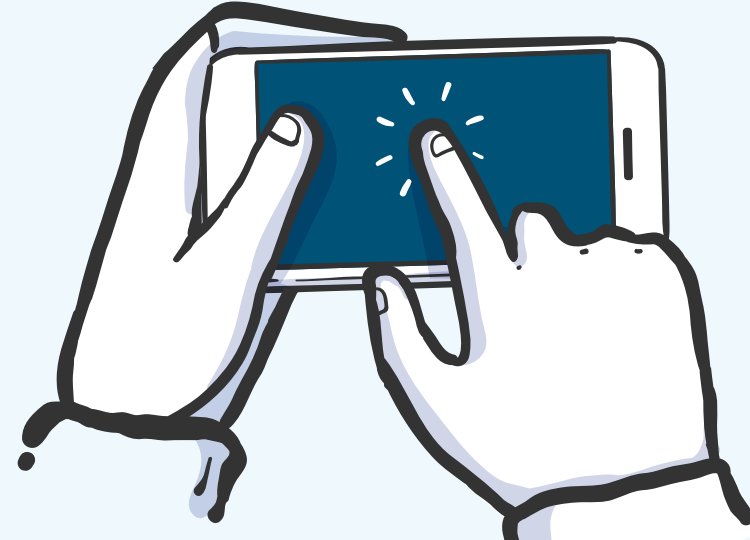
The iPhone 6 Plus weighs 172g, while the Galaxy Note 4 is slightly heavier at 176g and the Google Nexus 6 is the heaviest of the three at 182g. The iPhone 6 Plus is the most compact.

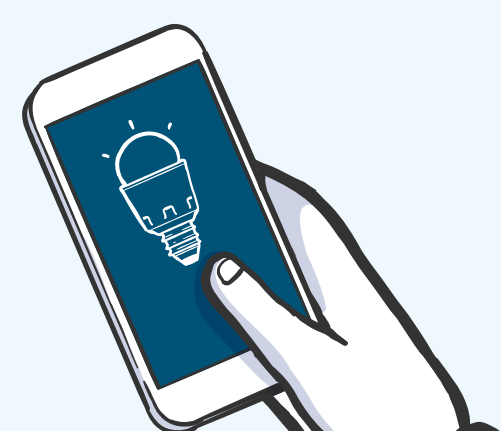
PROCESSOR

The Nexus 6 has an extremely powerful processor, maybe the strongest. The Apple iPhone 6 Plus appears to be the weakest of the three devices, but its software is optimized to perfection. The Note 4 is strong as well.

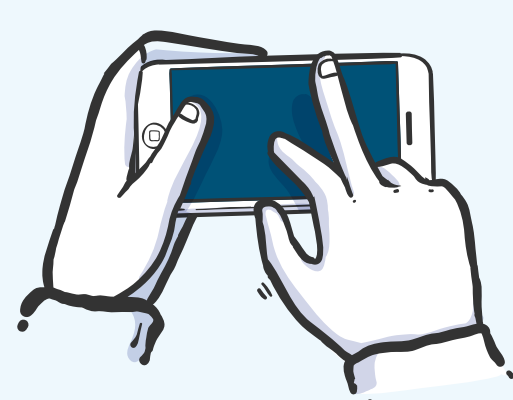

CAMERA

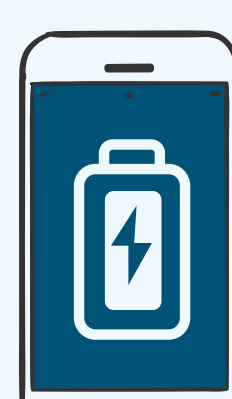
The Samsung Galaxy Note 4 and Nexus 6 cameras outrank the Apple iPhone 6 Plus in terms of megapixel rating. The Note 4 doesn't do well in low-light conditions. The Nexus also provides a 13-megapixel camera, which in tests proved to be better than the Note 4, but not quite as good as the iPhone. The iPhone 6 Plus has performed extremely well when tested. The iPhone seems to win this criteria in terms of quality and versatility even though you might say otherwise from the specifications.

BATTERY

The Note 4 has excellent battery life with its 3220 mAh battery that will provide the most life of the three. Then comes Nexus 6 and lastly the iPhone 6 plus which is just okay.
