About the microFIT Program

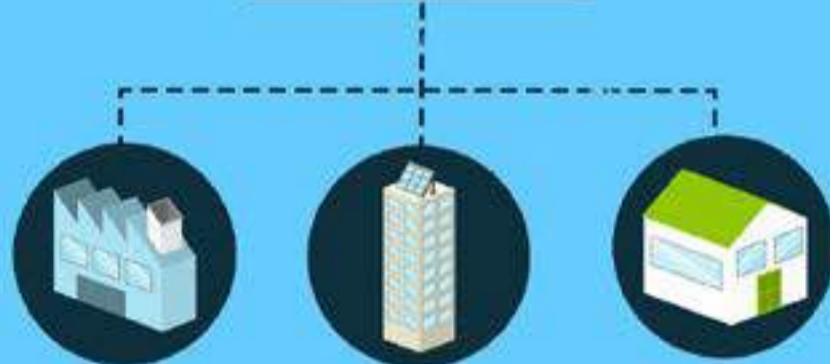
Ontario's government launched the microFIT program in 2009 to give eligible consumers the opportunity to develop their own micro renewable power generation project. Under the program, consumers can sell back the power they produce at a fixed price over a 20 year term.

Are you Eligible for the microFIT program?



To be eligible for the microFIT program, the following criteria must be met.

- ✓ A project must use a renewable fuel type such as solar photovoltaic
- ✓ The project must be based in Ontario
- ✓ The project must not have an existing contract with IESO or Ontario Power Authority contract
- ✓ The project must not have a Nameplate Capacity that is greater than 10 kW
- ✓ The project must be connected, directly or indirectly, to the IESO-controlled grid through the local distribution company
- ✓ The project must be connected to a separate meter as specified by the local distribution company
- ✓ Participants of the microFIT program must meet standards set by the IESO in the Eligible Participant Schedule
- ✓ The same applicant must maintain the microFIT generator account
- ✓ Individuals and farmers may only have one microFIT Project



Applying for microFIT

- STEP 01** Register online for the microFIT program
- STEP 02** Fill out and submit an application online and note down your registration number
- STEP 04** You submit a connection request to an applicable local distribution company (LDC)
- STEP 06** The LDC completes the connection and you're offered a microFIT contract

- STEP 03** Your application is reviewed for completeness and whether sufficient capacity remains within the Annual Procurement Target
- STEP 05** Once application approval is received, the microFIT project needs to be set up within 180 days
- STEP 07** Start getting paid for the energy you make!
