Pai has been pursuing his goal of deregulating the communications industry since he was appointed. In December 2017, Pai took a major step towards repealing the net neutrality protections that were instated in 2015. The FCC voted 3 – 2 in favour of repealing protection.

The impact this vote can have when it comes into effect can be huge, as currently, the rules ban the blocking or throttling of internet content or the prioritization of content in exchange for payment to home and mobile providers. The removal of this rule will cause a significant shift in the way consumers use the internet in 2018 and beyond.
